


SUSTAINABILITY

OUR VINEYARDS

Regenerative farming leads to healthier vines, resilient vineyards, and consistent quality – reducing vintage risk for the long-term

- ✓ All acreage is dedicated to planting native plants such as wild roses, lavender, and trees – providing an ecosystem for beneficial organisms that prevent pests
- ✓ Converting to no-till, full-grassing to eliminate mowing, diesel usage, soil compaction, and improve water retention
- ✓ Targeted grazing by sheep for natural weed control



OUR WINERY

We take sustainable practices beyond the vineyard to better our overall footprint

- ✓ Solar panels power all facility buildings, including cooling in the summer
- ✓ Transitioning to 100% recyclable craft paper in packaging & materials – impacting shipping weight, biodegradability, and overall carbon footprint
- ✓ Transitioning to light weight bottles for recycling efficiency, & resource conservation



OUR PEOPLE

Doing better for our people and our community leads to better vine health and better wines

- ✓ Full time vineyard team employed year-around with full benefits – ensuring long term institutional knowledge, consistency and accountability
